Sophia Agranovich, a Steinway Artist and internationally acclaimed soloist, chamber musician, recording artist and educator, is “a bold, daring pianist in the tradition of the Golden Age Romantics”, “a tigress of the keyboard” - Fanfare. Ms. Agranovich has performed in USA, Europe, Israel, and Canada, and has collaborated with renowned musicians and members of major orchestras. A First Prize winner of the Ukrainian Young Artists and the Bergen Philharmonic competitions, a recipient of a Gold Medal and four Silver Medals from Global Music Awards, two Gold Medals from Prestige Music Awards, Best Classical Solo from Akademia Music Awards, Best Classical Piano Album from Clouzine International Music Awards, and Albert Nelson Marquis Lifetime Achievement Award, she earned Bachelor and Master Degrees at Juilliard holding a full scholarship and teaching Fellowship, and continued Doctoral studies at Columbia University. Ms. Agranovich is an esteemed pedagogue, listed in ‘Who’s Who in America’ and ‘Who’s Who in the World’, NARAS voting member, Program Chair of Music Educators Association of NJ, and is the Director of Classical Music Series at the Watchung Arts Center.
